Chapter Meeting Minutes**

**Saturday, March 2, 2019
9:30 AM**

- Call to Order – Trey Hargus called the meeting to order at 9:30 AM. Approximately 90 members were present.
- Pledge to Flag – Trey Hargus led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag. Trey announced that Channel Five will be present at next month's meeting to record the HOG Chapter reciting the pledge to the flag.
